



AZARAQI

Seed

The drug *Azaraqi* consists of dried seeds of *Strychnos nux vomica* L. (Loganiaceae); the tree is found in tropical India upto 1200 m rarely in Bengal, common in Tamil Nadu and Tenasserim region of Burma. The flowering and fruiting occurs from February to April.

- **Temperament:** Hot 3°, Dry 3°
- **Action(s):** Resolvent (Mohallil), Blood purifier (Musaffi-e-Dam)
- **Therapeutic Use(s):** Hemiplegia(Falij), Facial palsy(Laqwa), Polyarthritis(Waja-ul-Mafasil), Low Backache(Waja-ul-Qatan), Bronchial asthma(Zeeq-un-Nafas), Pthisis(Sil), Gonorrhoea(Suzak)
- **Dose:** 60 - 250 mg.
