Fruit

The drug *Babchi* consists of dry ripe fruits of *Psoralea corylifolia* L. (Fabaceae); a drug yielding plant is an erect, 0.3-1.8 m. high annual herb, distributed throughout India, found commonly in Uttar Pradesh, Bengal and Maharashtra.

- Temperament: Hot & Dry 20
- Action(s): Blood purifier (Musaffi-e-Dam), Rubefacient (Mohammir-e-Jild), Stomachic (Muqawwi-e-Meda), Vermicide (Qatil-e-Deedan-e-Ama), Laxative (Mulaiyin).
- **Theraputic Use(s):** Abnormality of blood (Fasad-e-Dam), Leprosy (Juzam), Vitiligo (Bars), Pityriasis alba (Bahaq Abyaz).
- **Dose:** 3 to 5 g.
- Important Formulation(s): Sufoof-e-Bars
